Yasaka Shrine

In 1185-1190, when Ryugasaki was developed, it was built in Nemachi as a guardian of several from families.
In 1577, Kamimachi Yasaka shrine was moved to Kamimachi by Toki Tanetomo, the lord of Ryugasaki castle.
The Yasaka shrine Gion Festival is held in July where Tsukumai, a traditional art performance originating from Ryugasaki, held on Nemachi street on the last day of the festival.

10 Kisen Ryokan

It is a Japanese inn. You can enjoy original Ryugasaki croquettes. Its ingredients are changed each season. Also, you can eat "MAIN korokke" (MAIN croquettes) here.
