## Yasaka Shrine

In 1185-1190, when Ryugasaki was developed, it was built in Nemachi as a quardian of several from families.

In 1577, Kamimachi Yasaka shrine was moved to Kamimachi by Toki Tanetono, the lord of Rvugasaki castle.

The Yasaka shrine Gion Festival is held in July where Tsukumai, a traditional art performance originating from Ryugasaki, held on Nemachi streeet on the last day of the festival.
